# East of Suez – Glass Beads, Bangles, Mirrors and More from India

Talk by: Prof. Jan Kock, Aarhus University, Denmark



Technologies in the field of glass once used in Europe for more than thousand year is now forgotten but it is still possible to find and study these ethno-graphically in India. These cultural Treasure which are on the last phase of

their survival speaks more than what we know about our past.

Prof. Jan Kock teaches in the Dept. of Medieval and Renaissance Archaeology, Aarhus University, Denmark since 1994. He served as the Curator in the famous Aalborg Historical Museum, Denmark (1974-1994). His research contributions have been phenomenal in the field of Medieval Archaeology, Ethnoarchaeology, Study of Glass and History of Technology, and also Warfare. He is today one of the foremost authority in the field of glass studies.



He has traveled and documented in almost all corners of India where there is evidence of traditional glass technology.
